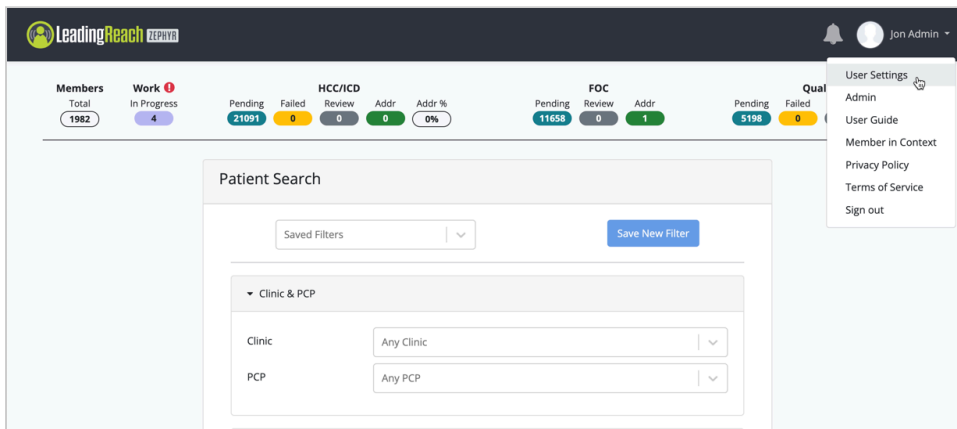
For Zephyr users, linking your Zephyr and LeadingReach profiles will eventually let you log in to LeadingReach from Zephyr without re-entering your credentials. This article explains how to link your user profiles.


## LINK YOUR USER PROFILES

To begin, log in to the Zephyr application (<https://zephyr.leadingreach.com/>).

1. In the Zephyr application, open the **User Settings** page.




## 2. Click **Link Account**.

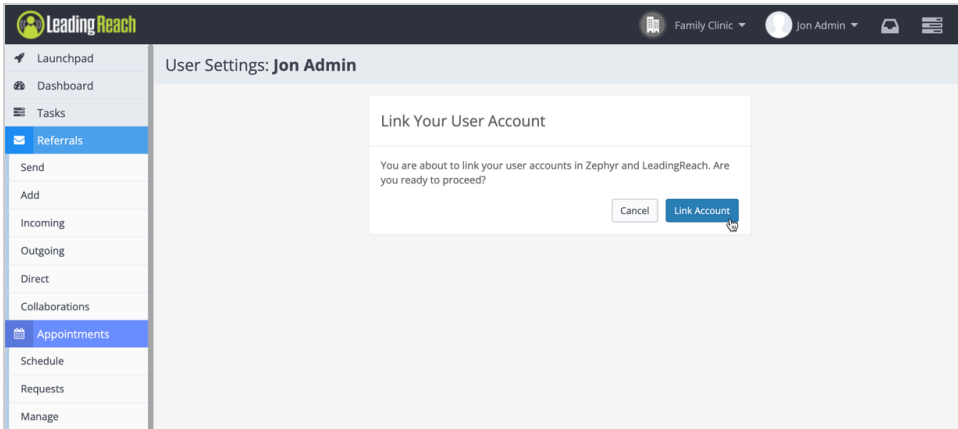
## 3. On the **Sign In** page that opens, enter your LeadingReach user credentials and then click **Sign In**.
